In reviewing the parties' filings regarding the named Federal Defendants' 24 Motion to Stay, the Court has determined that additional briefing from these Defendants is necessary as to two issues. First, Defendants shall provide an update as to the status of the review of Major Hasan's court-martial by the convening authority, including any revised estimate as to the completion of this process. Second, to the extent Defendants intend to file a Rule 12(b) motion to dismiss based on the Feres doctrine in this case, see *Feres v. United States*, 340 U.S. 135 (1950), Defendants shall further explain why concerns of unlawful command influence, or any other issues, would prevent them from filing such a motion during the pendency of this review. In their filings, Plaintiffs have repeatedly and forcefully argued that such a motion would not implicate concerns of unlawful command influence. Yet Defendants have responded to this argument only in a general, cursory manner. See Reply in Support of the Named Federal Defendants' Motion to Stay and in Opposition to Plaintiffs' Motion for Leave to Conduct Expedited Discovery, ECF No. 35 at 4 n. 4. Although the Court takes no position at this time as to the merits of a potential motion pursuant to the Feres doctrine, it notes the following. Under the Feres doctrine, "the Government is not liable under the Federal Tort Claims Act for injuries to servicemen where the injuries arose out of or are in the course of activity incident to service." *Feres*, 340 U.S. at 146. The Supreme Court has subsequently held that the doctrine bars not only FTCA claims, but also Bivens claims against the Government raised under the Constitution. See *United States v. Stanley*, 483 U.S. 669, 678 (1987). In determining which Bivens and FTCA claims are barred under the "incident to service" language in *Feres*, the D.C. Circuit has looked to three factors: "the injured service member's duty status, the site of the injury and the nature of the activity engaged in by the service member at the time of his injury...." *Schnitzer v. Harvey*, 389 F.3d 200, 203 (D.C. Cir. 2004) (citing *Verma v. United States*, 19 F.3d 646, 648 (D.C. Cir. 1994) (per curiam)). The Court reads these factors as setting out a primarily plaintiff-focused inquiry. Thus it would appear that in order to support a motion to dismiss based on the Feres doctrine, Defendants would need to identify the servicemember Plaintiffs' duty status at the time of the injury, where the injury occurred, and the nature of the activity engaged in by these Plaintiffs at the time of the injury. Based on the amended complaint, although Plaintiffs allege various antecedent negligent activities by the named Federal Defendants, the injury suffered appears to be the shooting itself which resulted in alleged physical and emotional harm. See, e.g., Amended Complaint, ECF No. 22 10, 243, 261, 262, 269, 270, 275, 276, 285, 287, 288, 294, 295. See also *Klay v. Panetta*, 924 F.Supp.2d 8, 16 (D.D.C. 2013), appeal docketed No. 13-5081 (D.C. Cir. filed March 6, 2013) (characterizing injury for Feres inquiry as immediate harm felt by plaintiffs rather than alleged negligence of supervisory officials). Consequently, the Court requests Defendants' input as to why a potential Feres motion would require them to take a position as to (1) whether Major Hasan is guilty or innocent and whether he specifically, rather than some unidentified shooter, was the cause of Plaintiff's injuries - the foundation of Defendants' contentions of potential unlawful command influence - as well as (2) the veracity of the Plaintiff's allegations regarding the negligent actions and/or inaction of the named Federal Defendants. Furthermore, the Court notes that for purposes of a Feres motion, it must accept the facts alleged by the plaintiff as true. See *Schnitzer*, 389 F.3d at 202. This means that even if Hasan's alleged role in the shooting and the alleged negligent actions and/or inaction of the Defendants were relevant to the Feres inquiry, it would appear that Defendants could simply craft their argument around the facts as alleged in Plaintiff's Amended Complaint, without taking a position as to veracity of these allegations and potentially generating unlawful command influence. Accordingly, in light of these concerns, the Court requests additional briefing from Defendants as to why potential unlawful command influence, or any other potential concerns, would prevent them from filing a planned Rule 12(b) motion based on the Feres doctrine during the pendency of the convening authority's review.
